Transformative Quantum Technologies is a collaborative research initiative at the University of Waterloo that aims to accelerate the development and deployment of impactful quantum devices. Through the Quantum Graduate Visitor Program, TQT seeks to grow the community of exceptional students who show a strong curiosity in advancing quantum research.

Visitors will have the opportunity to experience world-class infrastructure, explore quantum in new settings, and expand their network by collaborating with interdisciplinary researchers at the University of Waterloo. Stays can be arranged for up to 120 days, with travel expenses covered and a living stipend provided.

Transformative Quantum Technologies enthusiastically accepts applications from graduate students at the Master's or PhD level. To promote our commitment to a diverse research community, applications from members of the four designated groups – women, members of visible minorities, Indigenous peoples, and persons with disabilities – are encouraged.
